What's been your favorite class taken at St. Mark's? Why?


I loved my religion classes and the way that they brought about discussion and made me think outside of the box.


What's been your favorite class taken at St. Mark's? Why?

When the jv field hockey team won our Groton game, everyone celebrated, running around the field cheering. That moment I felt like I was truly part of something great.





Groton Night has been my favorite St. Mark's moment for the past two years. There is nothing better than the whole school getting together at night jumping around a bonfire excited for the next day's games.







What extracurricular activities are you involved in (sports, clubs, leadership positions)?




My first Groton Night was definitely my favorite St. Mark's memory, it was just electrifying and a great highlight.
